2018 Give Kids A Smile WEEK

Four local preschools get the full dentist office experience

Starting on national Give Kids A Smile Day, February 2nd, and continuing throughout the following week, generous volunteers from <u>Delta Dental</u> <u>of New Jersey Foundation</u>, Rutgers University and KinderSmile Foundation's "<u>Give Back a Smile</u>" professional volunteer program helped us welcome **99 children and their caregivers** into KinderSmile Community Oral Health Center.

This was the 11th annual Give Kids A Smile oral health fair that KinderSmile Foundation has held, but it's the first time ever that children were bussed to our very own dental home in Bloomfield rather than participating at the group fair in Montclair's Presbyterian Church. Teachers from participating Head Start programs commented that they loved this focused approach, giving each of their classes extra one-onone with the dentists and hygienists for **oral health education that will stick with the kids long after Children's Dental Health Month is over.**

A huge thank you to the volunteers who participated in this pilot effort. Without their help, we would never have been able to provide 79 children with oral exams, teeth cleanings and fluoride treatment, nor could we have taught them the basics of dental hygiene or fed them nutritious snacks.

A shocking statistic: More than half (53%) of all children seen required immediate follow-up care for restorative dental treatments, including fillings, crowns, extractions and "baby" root canal treatment.

New Community Partnerships

KinderSmile Oral Health Program has active MOUs with 35 local schools

KinderSmile Foundation has always derived its strength from partners like you. In particular, our close relationship with Head Start and Early Head Start programs as well as other local nonprofit organizations that also serve low-income families has enabled us to assist more than 13,000 families over the past decade.

In 2018, we are on track to complete 4,800 dental appointments for underserved kids and perinatal women-making it **the most productive year since inception**.

This is partially due to new dental home hours and a restructuring of the clinical staff, so that we can accommodate the schedules of busy, working families better. (Stay tuned to our next e-newsletter, which will introduce our new, fabulous dentists and dental assistants!)

But a huge reason why your support of KinderSmile Oral Health Program is proving to be a success in the community is evident by the overwhelming requests for partnerships which we have experienced in the past several months. Schools like Mildred Barry Garvin Elementary and Dionne Warwick Institute in East Orange have spread the word that **KSOHP is helping to decrease dental issues for their students**, and we have been welcomed into new school districts as a result. Principal Sturdivant calls Dr. Sara her "tooth angel."
