KinderSmile Oral Health Program

School-based oral health programs have been proven to be one of the most effective ways to reach children from at-risk families who have a higher risk of caries, and limited or no access to clinical care.

Our KSOHP Coordinator schedules bi-annual visits for oral health education and preventive dental care. At these visits, dentists, dental hygienists, and dental assistants provide age and ability appropriate oral health education, dental exams, prophylactic cleanings, fluoride varnish, and dental sealants where appropriate. All preventive dental care provided at school visits is provided at no cost to families, regardless of insurance status. KSOHP would not be possible without all our community partners. Thank you!

KSOHP Special Smiles

Special Smiles is an exciting expansion of Kindersmile Oral Health Program, providing access to dental care and oral health education at schools for children with developmental disabilities.

KSOHP Special Smiles addresses oral health education and preventive dental care to hundreds of developmentally disabled students and their caretakers, while promoting importance of routine, self-determination, and competency in oral hygiene and nutritional habits. The program integrates a link to a dental home where quality dental care can be continued if needed.

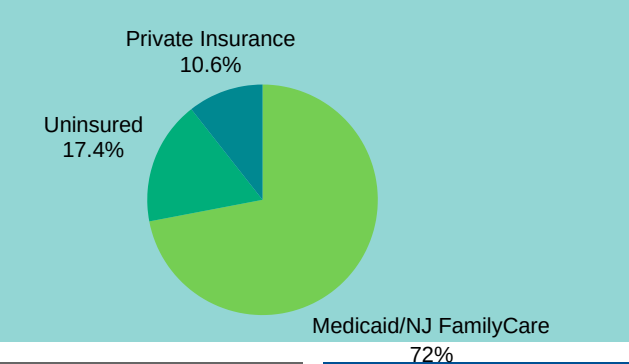
Give Kids A Smile Day



On February 1st, 2019 we celebrated our 12th annual Give Kids A Smile Day at Oakeside Bloomfield Cultural Center, where 162 preschool and elementary school students from Montclair, Orange, East Orange, Bloomfield, and Bellville received oral health education, dental exams, prophylaxis, and fluoride treatment at no cost to parents/caregivers or the schools.

Most of the children were bused to our event from local Head Start or Early Head Start programs. Children came from Montclair Child Development Center, East Orange Child Development Center, Union Township Community Action Organization, Neighborhood Child Care Center, Precious Jewels Child Care, and Belleville schools.

We had a day filled with fun oral health education, a magician, and most importantly, we were able to provide children access to dental care and a link to a Dental Home.

Perinatal Health & Wellness Program, Year 3

KinderSmile Perinatal Health and Wellness Program breaks the dangerous cycle of untreated dental diseases by empowering uninsured pregnant & recently postpartum women with informative, personal, culturally-sensitive training about the importance of maternal oral health and its impact on the developing fetus and young children under the mother's care.

"Graduates" of the training program earn a full year of free dental care to restore their smiles to full functionality and painlessness.

This year Dr. McGrath-Barnes was invited to First Lady of New Jersey Tammy Murphy's *Black Infant & Maternal Health Summit* for collaboration with leaders regarding the systemic factors of NJ's racial gap.

PHWP is perfectly aligned with First Lady Tammy Murphy's *Healthy Women, Healthy Families* program, which addresses the healthcare inequities in high-risk communities that impact maternal and infant health.

A new branch of the program in 2019, Bridging the Gap of Oral and Maternal Health, established a partnership with Clara Maass Hospital, where we lead tabling events and oral health education to perinatal mothers, addressing maternal health inequality in underserved communities.

Mothers are referred to KSCOHC Bloomfield for preventive and comprehensive dental care.

Linking Children to a Dental Home

KinderSmile Community Oral Health Centers of Bloomfield and Newark

KinderSmile Foundation combats the inequality in oral health care access in underserved communities by establishing a link to a Dental Home while focusing on the three key goals of education, prevention, and intervention.

KinderSmile Community Oral Health Center (KSCOHC) Bloomfield opened its doors in 2016, and has flourished since. Our Dental Home provides routine and comprehensive care to our community, eliminating the common barriers such as lack of insurance eligibility, ease of transportation, and convenient hours for working parents.

Over 90% of the children we serve come from at-risk families with income between 100-150% of the Federal Poverty Level.

In 2019 we partnered with the Boys and Girls Club of Newark to open our second Dental Home, KSCOHC Newark, bridging the gap in access to oral health care for underserved youth in the urban community of Newark. The City of Newark is designated as medically underserved by the Commissioner of Health and Senior Services.

This convenient Dental Home provides oral health education, prevention, and intervention for Club members and the surrounding community.

Community Service Learning Program & Annual Mission Trips

Thirty volunteers, students ranging from high school through graduate school, joined our Community Service Learning Program (CSLP) in 2019. These ambitious future leaders go on to become dentists, public health advocates, or have careers in business or education. Our interns and volunteers participate in clinical, administrative, and outreach at our dental home and community programs. They are valued and integral members of the KinderSmile team. Thank you!

Our Community Service Learning Program volunteers had the opportunity to join two global mission trips in 2019. In April, our 14th annual mission trip team traveled to the village of Yunguillo, near Quito, Ecuador, where they spent 4 full days of community service providing comprehensive dental care to 375 patients. Value of care was an astounding \$137,650!

In August, a group of volunteers were off to KinderSmile Foundation's 15th global mission trip, where they provided \$97,255 worth of dental care to 250 patients in Croix des Bouquets, a remote village in Haiti with no running water, electricity, or access to dental or medical care.
