We envision a future where every child has access to a dentist, and preventable dental diseases are eradicated.

In 2021, despite continued challenges caused by the coronavirus pandemic, KinderSmile Foundation continued to grow and to positively impact the communities we serve. This year validated that the need for our services is greater than ever. Health inequities continue to plague the inner cities, highlighting socioeconomic and racial disparities in access to care. Black and Hispanic communities have been disproportionately affected by COVID-19, and are uninsured at higher rates. The CDC states that health equity is attained when everyone has the opportunity to reach full health potential without the disadvantages of social or economic circumstances. KinderSmile Foundation strives to achieve just that!

It is my pleasure to share our growth, successes, and impact of 2021. We hosted a successful Give Kids a Smile Month in February. We developed a successful Introduction to Dental Assisting Program in partnership with Mercer County Community College, and celebrated the commencement of the first class of graduates in July. We continued to provide access to oral health care through KinderSmile Oral Health Program, Special Smiles Program, our Perinatal Health and Wellness Program, and at our three Dental Homes.

Our Mission and Vision

The mission of KinderSmile Foundation is to provide underserved children with access to comprehensive dental care and educate underserved children and their families on the importance of dental hygiene. We envision a future where every child has access to a dentist, and preventable dental diseases are eradicated.

Our expansion to the medically compromised City of Trenton has broadened our mission to include underserved adults, responding to the dire need of the community.

Over the past 15 years, KinderSmile Foundation has provided more than \$9 million of in-kind dental services, and impacted over 35,000 underserved patients in New Jersey and abroad, in order to eliminate dental disease, the #1 epidemic of economically disadvantaged children.

Our evidence-based approach relies on three goals of Education, Prevention, and Intervention as methods to combat dental disease and empower children and their caregivers with knowledge about oral hygiene and its relevance to total health and wellness by providing compassionate, culturally-sensitive oral hygiene instruction and nutritional counseling.


















Caries Risk Assessment 22.98% 24.87% 52.14% High Moderate Low

Give Kids a Smile

We celebrated KinderSmile Foundation's 14th annual Give Kids A Smile for the entire month of February, 2021, in all three of our Dental Homes.

We provided free oral health education and dental care to **391 underserved children** in Bloomfield, Newark, and Trenton.

We are grateful to the ADA, NJDA, The Delta Dental of NJ Foundation, and all of our professional and Community Service Learning program volunteers who took part in this month-long event.

The total in-kind value of care provided was an astounding \$143,457.06!







Perinatal Health and Wellness Program

KinderSmile Perinatal Health and Wellness
Program (PHWP) breaks the dangerous cycle of
untreated dental diseases by empowering
uninsured pregnant and up to three years
postpartum women with informative, personal,
culturally-sensitive training about the
importance of maternal oral health and its
impact on the developing fetus and young
children. Graduates of the training program
earn a full year of free dental care to restore
their smiles to full functionality and painlessness,
and the benefit of having a link to a Dental
Home for their children from their first year. In
2021, we proudly enrolled and educated 60
new PHWP moms.

PHWP is perfectly aligned with First Lady Tammy Murphy's Nurture NJ and Healthy Women, Healthy Families program, addressing the healthcare inequities in high-risk communities that impact maternal and infant health.

Our expansion into Trenton extended the reach of this program to the underserved perinatal mothers of the City of Trenton, where it is reported that 58% of expectant Trenton mothers receive late or no prenatal health care.





















KinderSmile Foundation combats the inequality in oral health care access in underserved communities by establishing a link to a Dental Home while focusing on the three key goals of education, prevention, and intervention. The Surgeon General's Oral Health Report concluded that although dental diseases are preventable, many face barriers that prevent access to oral health care in a timely fashion. The mission of KSF is to eliminate these barriers, and expand access to care.

The health and safety of our staff, patients, and community remains our priority. The ability to continue to provide quality dental care throughout the coronavirus pandemic has been valuable. Despite the increase in need and cost of PPE and infection control supplies due to this pandemic, we continue our mission of providing care to at-risk patients without seeking any additional fees from our patients.

KinderSmile Foundation was founded in the community and for the community, and despite this year's challenges and limitations, we have been excited to return to our partners with **KinderSmile Oral Health Program** dental offsite visits and oral health education, adding a newly developed slideshow and virtual instructional program.

School-based oral health programs have been proven to be an effective way to reach children from at-risk families who have a higher risk of caries, and limited or no access to clinical care. Our KSOHP Coordinator schedules bi-annual visits for oral health education and preventive dental care. At these visits, dentists, dental hygienists, and dental assistants provide age and ability appropriate oral health education, dental exams, prophylactic cleanings, fluoride varnish, and dental sealants where appropriate. Preventive dental care provided at school visits is provided at no cost to families, regardless of insurance status. Our Special Smiles Program is an exciting expansion of the KinderSmile Oral Health Program, providing access to dental care and oral health education to schools serving children with developmental disabilities.

KinderSmile Community Oral Health Center Bloomfield, our first Dental Home, opened in 2016, creating our brick-and-mortar Dental Home model, free of the typical barriers in access to care that underserved communities face. Our Dental Homes accept all patients regardless of insurance status or lack thereof, offer ease of transportation, flexible hours for working parents, care for children with anxiety or developmental disabilities, and more.

KinderSmile Community Oral Health Center Newark, located within The Boys and Girls Club of Newark, bridges the gap in access to oral health care for underserved youth in the urban community of Newark. This convenient Dental Home, which opened in 2019, provides oral health education, prevention, and intervention for Club members and the surrounding community.

KinderSmile Community Oral Health Center Trenton fills a large gap in the community's available resources. With the help of our grantors and the growing list of our community partners, we celebrate the expansion of our services to providing quality comprehensive dental care for adults and children alike. Adult programs in Trenton include our Perinatal Health and Wellness Program, our Veterans Health and Wellness Program, and our Smiles for Seniors Program, which have all been developed in order to extend the reach and close the gap in oral health care access.
